



THE “WHAT IF” GAME

**** Parents please review and discuss with your child****

1. What if you're in the rest room at school when two big kids pull a knife, corner you, and ask you for you money? You should...

- a. Turn and run as fast as you can.
- b. Admire the knife and ask where they got it.
- c. Tell them that you know karate and if they don't ease off you'll will use it.
- d. Give them the money and walk away. Then report it to a parent, police officer, or teacher. Don't fight or argue with anyone with a weapon.

2. What if a friend of yours comes up and offers you some drugs. You should...

- a. Tell your friend “no thanks’ and if she’s a real friend she won’t offer them to you anymore.
- b. Say, “I’ve never tried that stuff. People say it could kill me.”
- c. Tell him no because you’ve got to get home to clean your room.
- d. Tell her no and ask her what she thinks drugs are doing to her body.

3. What if you see a knife or gun in another kid’s locker at school? You should...

- a. Tell a trusted adult--a teacher, counselor, parent or police officer.
- b. Pretend you never saw it and try to forget about it.
- c. Tell all your friends so they can bring in their weapons for show an tell.

4. What if you are home alone and a stranger knocks at the door.? You should...

- a.. Yell through a closed door that you are home alone and to go away.
- b. Ignore the knock because you know you should never open the door to a stranger when you're alone. If you're scared, call your parents or a neighbor you trust for advice or help.
- c. Open the door and take a closer look.

5. What if you are walking down the hallway in school and a bully tries to pick a fight with you. You should...

- a. Tell the bully you will meet him after school when you are off school property.
- b. Look the bully directly in the eyes and strongly tell the bully you don't want to participate.
- c. Remove yourself from the situation and walk away.
- d. Tell a school counselor or another adult about the bully.

- Answers:**
1. (d) Give them the money and walk away.
 2. (a-b-c-d) Each of these answers can be right, as long as you say no!
 3. (a) Weapons are serious trouble and should be reported immediately to a trusted adult who will protect all children's safety.
 4. (b) Make sure you and your family agree on rules you will follow if you are home alone.
 5. (b-c-d) You should do all three. Only use the techniques you have learned in class to

protect yourself if you are attacked.
