★EVENTS - PURPLE BELTS & ABOVE ★

SPARRING - As in weekly class, this event is for points only. It is very light contact. Excessive force results in disqualification. Chest protectors and headgear provided. Please bring and label any personal sparring gear. *Mouthpieces are mandatory and boys must wear groin cups.* (There will be a Safety Rules seminar/demonstration prior to sparring competition.)

OPEN FORMS - Contenders have 20 - 30 seconds to perform any form learned in class or a string of techniques they put together from techniques taught in class appropriate for their rank. Contenders will be judged on technique, coordination, balance, focus, speed, power and kiais.

★EVENTS - YELLOW AND ORANGE BELTS ★

SPARRING - As in weekly class, this event is for points only. It is very light contact. Excessive force results in disqualification. Chest protectors and headgear provided. Please bring and label any personal sparring gear. *Mouthpieces are mandatory and boys must wear groin cups.* (There will be a Safety Rules seminar/demonstration prior to sparring competition.)

SHOW WHAT YOU KNOW – While the judge calls out different techniques (Kicks, punches and block combinations, taught in class.) Contenders demonstrate them. Students perform twice. Judges look for effort, good technique, coordination, balance, focus, speed, power and kiai.

★EVENTS - WHITE BELT ★

DANGER ALLEY - In this exciting event contenders work their way through four “would be” attackers using their Self-Defense skills (break aways blocks, punches, kicks, and verbal skills). Judges look for effort, good technique, coordination, balance, focus, speed, reaction time, power, kiai and verbal skills.

BEST KICK & PUNCH - In this event contenders twice perform their best *front snap kick and reverse punch*. Judges look for effort, good technique, coordination, balance, focus, speed, power and kiai.

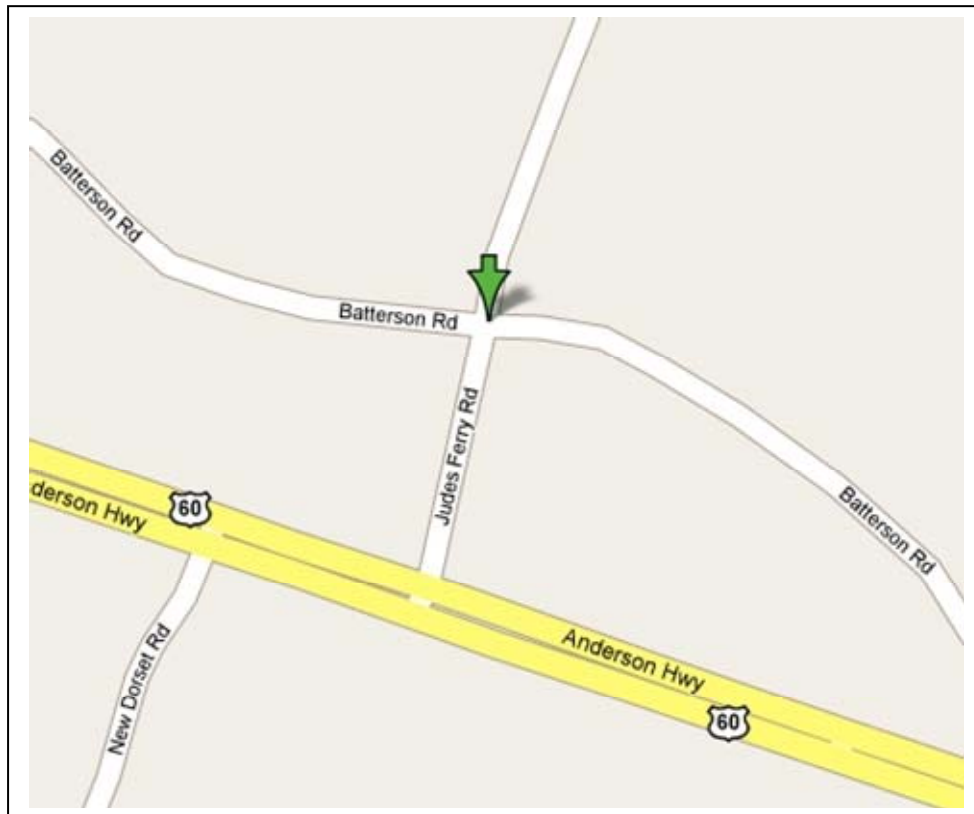

From Richmond:

Take Midlothian Turnpike (Rt 60) west into Powhatan County. Take right at third stoplight in Powhatan (Judes Ferry Rd), school is 1/8 mile on your right.

From Fredericksburg / Northern VA

Take I-95 South to 295 toward Charlottesville (West). Drive for about 15-20 minutes. Turn on the Exit toward Charlottesville (Interstate 64 West). Take Exit onto Route 288 South. Drive for about 20-25 minutes. Take Route 60 Exit (West) toward Powhatan County. Take right at third stoplight in Powhatan (Judes Ferry Rd). You will see the Bank of Powhatan on the right. School is 1/8 mile on your right.

From Williamsburg / Norfolk / Virginia Beach

Take I-64 West to 195 (Powhite Parkway). Take Powhite (toll road, costs \$0.75) to Midlothian Turnpike (Rt 60) west. Take Midlothian Turnpike west into Powhatan County. Take right at third stoplight in Powhatan (Judes Ferry Rd), school is 1/8 mile on your right. OR - Take I- 64 West. 295 towards Charlottesville (No tolls, less traffic) then pick up 288 south. Drive for about 20-25 minutes. Take Route 60 Exit (West) toward Powhatan County. Take right at third stoplight in Powhatan (Judes Ferry Rd). You will see the Bank of Powhatan on the right. School is 1/8 mile on your right.

From Petersburg / Emporia

Take I-95 North to Rt 288 North. Continue on Rt288 and take the Powhatan exit west on Rt 60. Take Midlothian Turnpike(60) west into Powhatan County. Take right at third stoplight in Powhatan (Judes Ferry Rd), school is 1/8 mile on your right.

From Charlottesville

Take I-64 East to Rt 288. Take Exit onto Route 288 South. Drive for about 20-25 minutes. Take Route 60 Exit (West) toward Powhatan County. Take right at third stoplight in Powhatan (Judes Ferry Rd). You will see the Bank of Powhatan on the right. School is 1/8 mile on your right.

From Lynchburg / Roanoke

Take Rt 460 East to Farmville exit. Take Rt. 45 North through Town of Farmville to Rt 60 east. Turn right onto Rt 60 East, follow into Powhatan County. Take left at fifth stoplight (Judes Ferry Rd), school is 1/8 mile on your right.
